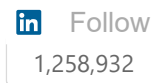

The City of Carlsbad is accepting applications for the position of Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent. This person plans, establishes priorities, assigns, and inspects the work of subordinate staff to ensure safe and efficient operation of plant in compliance with state and Federal regulations; monitors and evaluates job performance; provides on-the-job training.

Recommends and monitors budget; reviews purchase orders; conducts organizational planning, estimating staff, equipment and material requirements. Ensures permit and overall regulatory compliance. Supervises the maintenance of the Wastewater Treatment Plant's facilities and equipment. Schedules and supervises the scheduled draining, cleaning and repair of plant basins.

Has knowledge of principles and practices of supervision, including employee training and evaluation. Knowledge of methods, principles, practices, and equipment used in wastewater treatment. Knowledge of state and Federal regulations, standards, and criteria for wastewater treatment, plant operation, and discharge of effluent. Knowledge of wastewater-related laboratory procedures, methodology, calculations, and principles.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff, other departments, and the public. Ability to understand and interpret complex rules, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Qualifications: Extensive college coursework with a focus on Chemistry, Microbiology, Math, or related Engineering field; and seven (7) years of experience in wastewater treatment plant operation and maintenance, two (2) of which must have been as a supervisor or foreman.
