**Qualifications/Duties

- The purpose of this position is to maintain the base water treatment plant and auxiliary equipment.
- The position requires the incumbent to possess a Water Treatment Plant Operators Certification or its equivalent in accordance with Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requirements and State of New Mexico requirements.
 - New Mexico Water Certification Level 1, 2, 3, or 4 or equivalent from another state.
 - Must be accepted through New Mexico Environmental Department reciprocity program.
- Ensures tasks are performed in accordance with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), State of New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), and Kirtland Air Force Base instructions, policies, and standards.
- Maintain the base water treatment plant production system and all auxiliary equipment.
- Experience with deep line shaft turbine groundwater wells, chlorination systems, water pumping stations, and potable water storage tanks.
- Collects water samples and tests drinking water using standard chemical test.
- Performs maintenance; such as oiling, greasing, cleaning, replacing gaskets, piping, and mechanical seals.
- Maintains records, logs, and documents operator actions.
- Properly uses, maintains, and accounts for all types of hand and/or power tools required to accomplish assigned duties.
- Accurately performs preventive maintenance within established schedules and guidelines.
- Must pass a pre-employment drug screening, a physical, and lift test.
